

# TCNJ's "Promise" Award

## For Freshman and Sophomores

- Established in 2004, the TCNJ EOF Promise Award provides additional financial support for our state's parents and students to attend an institution of higher education in New Jersey where the financial need exceeds the financial aid available. (Unique to The College of New Jersey)
- The EOF Promise Award was designed to meet the **full cost** to attend TCNJ, both the direct and indirect costs, including on-campus residency.
- Continued Promise Award eligibility; sophomore year, is based on the student's satisfactory progress and successful completion of 6 units and a minimum GPA of 2.0

# TCNJ's "Incentive" Merit Award

## For Juniors and Seniors

- An extension of the Promise Award based on continued academic progress.
- The award is determined by total units earned at the end of the students sophomore and junior years, as well as their cumulative gpa.
- There are 4 award levels. The maximum award is \$5000.00 per academic year.
